CITY OF KIRKLAND NOTICE OF APPEAL HEARING BEFORE HEARING EXAMINER

PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF APPEAL: Appeal of Planning Director decision on Permit No. [SUB14-01033](#) regarding a request for Proposed 2 lot Short Plat on a vacant lot, Lot 3: 5,015 sf and Lot 4: 7,204 sf. A 15' wide access easement from 128th Ave NE will be provided. Appellant alleges that the decision is in error because the short plat does not comply with various development standards found within the Kirkland Municipal Code and Kirkland Zoning Code, and especially in regard to tree retention regulations.

PUBLIC HEARING: Will be held before the Kirkland Hearing Examiner on May 21, 2015 at 9:00 a.m., (or as soon thereafter as possible) in the Council Chamber at 123 5th Avenue.

NATURE OF AND PARTICIPATION IN APPEAL: Only the applicant, city staff, and any person who submitted written comments to the Planning Director may participate in the appeal. These persons may participate by providing written arguments to the Hearing Examiner before or at the hearing or by appearing at the meeting in person, or through a representative and providing oral arguments directly to the Hearing Examiner. The scope of the appeal is limited to the specific factual findings and conclusions disputed in the letter of appeal and the Hearing Examiner may only consider arguments on these factual findings and conclusions. The Hearing Examiner may reasonably limit the extent of the oral arguments to facilitate the orderly and timely conduct of the hearing.
